The staff and I are looking forward to the new school year in September.



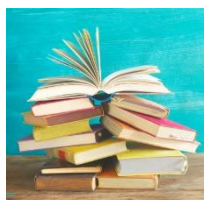
Please refer to Seesaw for detailed information of your child's **school trip**. We have a very busy few weeks ahead.
