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Diolch yn fawr PC Stu for coming to school on Wednesday to deliver key messages to

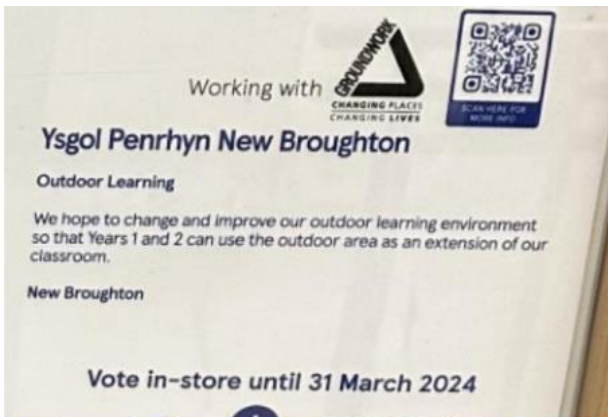
- ~ Reception - they learnt about Stranger Danger
