On Monday, Year 3 had a wonderful music session with Mrs Ellis from Wrexham Music Co-Operative. We had a session with the P-Buzz instrument which is part of the brass family. (The family that includes trumpets and trombones.)

We started off with a, 'Shakedown' warm up and learnt about a famous musician called John Williams. He wrote the music for Star Wars!

We thought about how his music made us feel and discussed the dynamics of his music (How loud and quiet it is) as well as the rhythm (Long and short notes)

We learnt that the P-Buzz has three parts: Bell, slide and mouth piece.

First, we had a practise with the mouthpiece and then were ready to play the instrument.

It made a very funny sound!

We played the 'Don't buzz this one back' game and played along to music by Queen called, 'We Will Rock You!' Diolch Mrs Ellis for a fun music session. We can't wait to welcome you back next month when we will be having our glockenspiel session!
