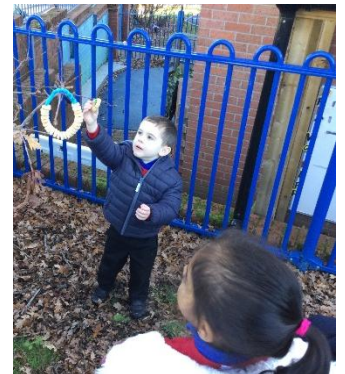

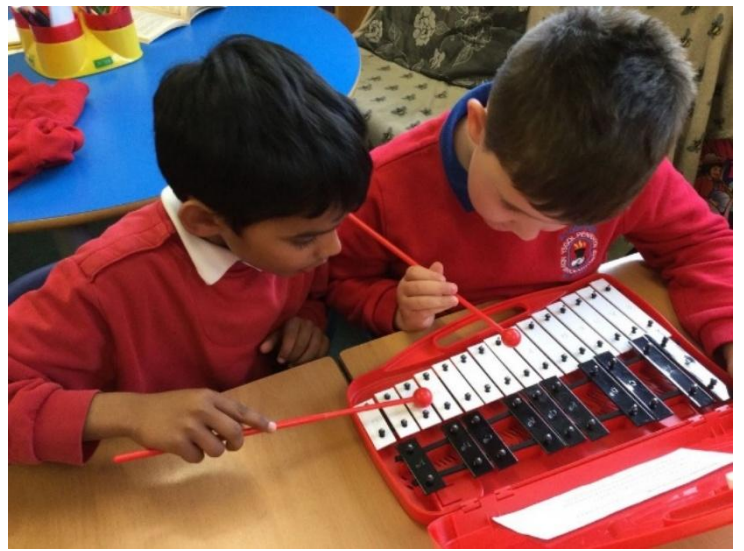

On Monday, Miss Ellis from Wrexham Music Co-Operative came to visit **Year 3** to deliver a music lesson with glockenspiels. First we re-capped the previous lesson when we played the P-Buzz instrument. Miss Ellis was super impressed that we remembered that it was part of the brass family.

We started this lesson by playing the, 'Don't clap this one back,' game which was a fun warm up!

We went onto learn information about a composer called John Williams who wrote the music, 'Hedwig's Theme' from the film, 'Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone.' The main melody for this piece of music is played using a glockenspiel!

We listened for the pulse and reminded ourselves of the rhythm and listened for long and short notes.

We then worked in partners to begin to learn how to play the glockenspiel correctly. We played some notes and realised that the tune reminded us of a familiar song- it was Jingle Bells!

We were given the notes to follow and played on the glockenspiel. There was even a bit in the middle where we could make up our own tune (Improvisation)

Diolch for another wonderful lesson Miss Ellis. We will look forward to welcoming you back after Christmas for our next session which will be focussing on singing.

"I liked the glockenspiel when we played Jingle Bells," - **Hallie**

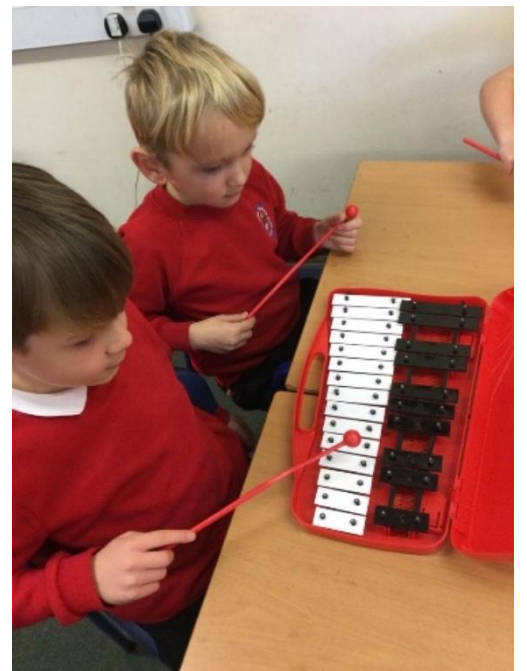
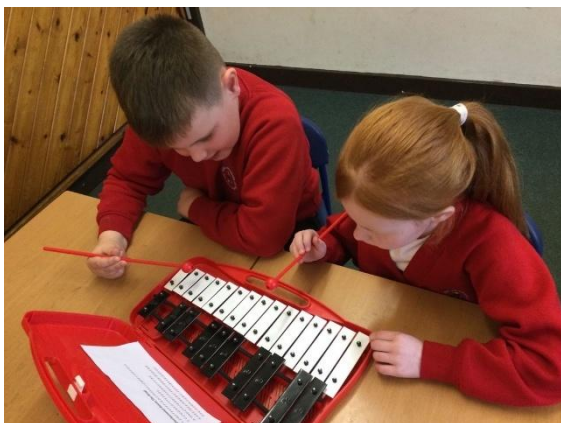
"It was really fun and thank you!" - **Afan**

"We learnt a lot of safety stuff, like CPR, but never use it for fun, only in an emergency. When someone is choking you can use this method, pat them on the back three times and if that does not work use thrusts for 5 times."

"Today Sophie came in to teach us about First Aid and a recap on CPR and about critical bleeds and how to stop the blood. We also learned how to stop someone from choking and how to help them. She showed us the shock position and recapped how to use a defibrillator." Brooke
