Our Eco Council have meetings every Friday where we work together to help make our school better and look after the environment.

In September, we started by doing something called an Eco Review. This means we looked closely at what our school is already doing to help the planet and what we could improve. We talked about things like recycling, saving energy, and looking after nature. One important thing we discovered was that we didn't have enough recycling bins for paper, so that became one of our goals to fix!

After that, we created an action plan. This is a list of all the things we want to improve and how we are going to do them. We had lots of discussions and shared ideas. For example, we thought about whether it is better for the environment to use paper towels or hand dryers. We enjoyed learning about how small changes can make a big difference.

We also explored ways to help our forest school area. We wondered if we could collect rainwater to use for watering plants. It was a great idea, but when we checked the water, we found it was too dirty to use safely. Even though it didn't work out, we learned a lot by trying!

At the same time, we worked together to create an eco-code. This is a set of rules and promised to help everyone in our school take care of the environment. We made it fun and easy to understand so everyone can follow it.

We are really proud because all of our hard work helped us achieve our Bronze Award, and then we even went on to get our Silver Award too! Now we are super excited and working hard towards our Gold Award. We can't wait to see what we can achieve next!
